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1 **[PROPOSED] ORDER**

2 The Court, having read and considered the Parties’ Joint Stipulation to Approve
3 Supplemental Notice by Publication, Increase Settlement Administration Costs, and Continue
4 Final Approval Hearing Date, and for GOOD CAUSE shown, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 5 1. The Parties request to have the settlement administrator finalize and mail notices
6 to settlement class members with address information within 10 business days of
7 the Court approving the updated administration bid and implementation schedule
8 (which the Parties anticipate will occur by December 5, 2022) or no later than
9 Monday, December 19, 2022, is GRANTED.
- 10 2. The Parties request to provide Notice by media Publication to those Class
11 members whose address could not be located is GRANTED. The Settlement
12 Administrator is directed to have the advertisement text submitted in Exhibit A
13 advertised on Facebook, YouTube, Google, and other media websites at the
14 commencement of the Notice Period (but no later than December 19, 2022),
15 targeting users in California that states “Did you work for Golden Labor
16 Services, LLC at Pacific Ag Management, Inc. in Kern County between
17 November 16, 2016, and October 31, 2021. Please click the link to see if you
18 may be entitled to monetary compensation.” and (ii) provide a link to the
19 Settlement Website. This advertisement will run for 45 consecutive days. This
20 advertisement will run starting no later than 10 business days from the Court’s
21 approval of the Notice by Publication or December 19, 2022.
- 22 3. The Parties request to approve the updated settlement administration costs of up
23 to \$25,000 is GRANTED.
- 24 4. The revised implementation schedule is now as follows:


