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TO THE HONORABLE COURT, PARTIES, AND ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

Plaintiffs Dulce Maria Santacruz Sanchez and Salud Santacruz ("Plaintiffs") and Defendants Golden Labor Services, LLC and Pacific Ag Management, Inc. ("Defendants") (collectively, the "Parties"), respectfully submit the following Joint Stipulation to Approve Supplemental Notice by Publication and Broadcast, Increase Settlement Administration Costs, and Continue Final Approval Hearing Date.

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2022, the Court held a hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement and issued an Order granting preliminary approval of the settlement ("Order");

WHEREAS, per the Court's Order, Notice to the Settlement Class was to be mailed by February 3, 2022 (resulting in a response deadline of March 21, 2022);

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen delays as a result of the format and condition of the multiple data files containing class member information, Defendants provided the class contact information to the Court appointed third-party administrator, ILYM Group Inc., ("ILYM") on February 7, 2022, and the PAGA Class payments based on Pay Periods on March 9, 2022;

WHEREAS, ILYM subsequently advised Defendants that in reviewing the data provided by Defendants, a few discrepancies were identified, and thus, Defendants worked with ILYM to resolve such discrepancies;

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2022, Defendants provided ILYM with an updated list with the Class information that resolved the discrepancies identified by ILYM;

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2022, ILYM informed Defendants that additional discrepancies were discovered, including duplicates and missing addresses and/or Social Security numbers, and thus, on June 15, 2022, Defendants provided ILYM with an updated Class list that sought to resolve all or most of the discrepancies identified by ILYM;

WHEREAS, as a result of the foregoing, the Parties filed a stipulation, requesting a continuance of the hearing of the Motion for Final Approval of the Class Action Settlement, which the Court approved on July 14, 2022, and ordered that the hearing be continued from July 26, 2022, to December 5, 2022;

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2022, ILYM informed Defendants that after reviewing the data provided for 3,541 potential class members, and that after using the resources typically utilized by settlement administrators to locate potential class members, ILYM's skip tracing efforts, ILYM was unable to locate a mailing address for 659 potential class members out of the 3,541 potential class members;

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2022, Defendants provided revised class contact information to ILYM, for 110 of the 659 potential class members whose mailing address could not be located;

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen delays as a result of Defendants attempting to identify and locate the addresses for the 659 of the 3,541 potential settlement class members, and provide that information to the settlement administrator, mailing of the notice packets to the settlement class members for whom addresses were located has not yet taken place;

WHEREAS, as of today's date, ILYM has been unable to locate a mailing address for 545 potential class members;

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.776(f), the Court has the authority and discretion to order notice by publication, broadcasting, or other means "reasonably calculated to apprise the class members of the pendency of the action" where it appears that it will not be possible to notify all members personally. *See* C.R.C. 3.776(f);

WHEREAS, with respect to those class members for whom Defendants and ILYM were unable to locate address information, the Parties wish, at the commencement of the Notice Period, for the Settlement Administrator to provide media notice through running an advertisement on multiple media sites such as Facebook, YouTube, Google and others targeting users in California that states "Did you work for Golden Labor Services, LLC at Pacific Ag Management, Inc. in Kern County between November 16, 2016, and October 31, 2021. Please click the link to see if you may be entitled to monetary compensation." and (ii) provides a link to the Settlement Website. This advertisement will run for 45 consecutive days. This advertisement will run starting no later than 10 business days from the Court's approval of the Notice by Publication or December 19, 2022. Mock-ups of the proposed advertisement for the various websites are attached as Exhibit A to the Declaration of Sean Hartranft in support of Stipulation and Proposed Order Regarding

Supplemental Noticing and Revised Administrative Costs.

WHEREAS, class members who received notice by media publication will have 60 days to respond, or until February 17, 2023, to object or request exclusion.

WHEREAS, after accounting for the decreased administration cost associated with mailing fewer notices than originally anticipated, as well as the additional data analysis costs and costs of providing notice by publication with Facebook, YouTube, Google, and other websites, ILYM has provided an updated bid to administer the settlement showing the original administrative costs not to exceed bid of \$20,000 increased \$5,000 to a revised bid of not to exceed \$25,000 for its administrative cost. (See Exhibit B in attached Declaration of Sean Hartranft in support of Stipulation and Proposed Order regarding Supplemental Noticing and Revised Administrative Costs);

WHEREAS, ILYM has indicated it will be able to finalize and mail notices to settlement class members with address information within 10 business days of the Court approving the updated administration bid and implementation schedule (which the Parties anticipate will occur by December 5, 2022) or no later than Monday, December 19, 2022;

WHEREAS, the hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement is currently scheduled for December 5, 2022 (which will be less than 16 court days for Class Counsel to file its Motion for Final Approval of Settlement prior to the updated response deadline);

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby stipulated by and between the Parties and respectfully requested that the Court GRANT the Parties' request:

- The settlement administrator will finalize and mail notices to settlement class members with address information within 10 business days of the Court approving the updated administration bid and implementation schedule (which the Parties anticipate will occur by December 5, 2022) or no later than Monday, December 19, 2022;
- The settlement administrator will provide supplemental media notice by publication through running a banner advertisement on Facebook, YouTube, Google, and other
